THINGS TO CONSIDER

- When and where was deceased born
- Nick names and/or names known to others
- Parents names / where they met and married
- Brothers, sisters, and place in family
- Early childhood / localities and interests
- Schools attended, awards given
- Academic or trade qualifications and achievements
- Some interesting stories about childhood days
- Details of any War or military service
- Details of marriages, divorces, significant relationships
- Details of children, grandchildren and great grandchildren
- Details of any club memberships, church involvement, positions held
- Details of sporting achievements
- Details of hobbies or interests, travel, crafts
- Details of historical significance
- Preferences, likes and dislikes / activities (e.g. music, theatre)
- Special stories, sayings, or qualities that are significant to others
- Special reading, music or poetry to be included
